

DRESSING AREA GUIDELINES

Grapevine High School

Each team will be assigned a private/semi-private dressing area. Rooms will be assigned according to registration with MA and in consideration for your team's size. The larger locker rooms may have more than one team assigned to the area. We are asking for your assistance in assuring that your dressing area is clean after the contest. Please understand that most of the dressing areas are teachers' classrooms, and they are being gracious in allowing us to use them for this purpose. Please observe the following guidelines in your particular dressing area:

***Positively, no food or drink allowed in the classrooms.**

Our classrooms and locker rooms are all carpeted. Food and drink are not allowed in the carpeted areas of our school.

***The dressing areas are not secured. Each team is responsible for the care and keeping of all personal and team items.** Grapevine High School Fillies, the Fillies Booster Club, and Marching Auxiliaries cannot be held responsible for lost or damaged items.

***Please "clean and clear" your dressing area to the best of your ability.**

This involved picking up all discarded bobbie pins, safety pins, trash, etc. Every team will be given two trash bags upon arrival for this purpose.

***Due to time constraints on the janitorial staff, you will need to "clean and clear" your dressing area prior to awards.**

***A cleaning fee of \$25.00 will be charged for each room that is not considered "clean and clear" by the custodial staff and myself upon final walk through after the contest.**

It is imperative that all rooms be left in good condition so that I may continue to offer the private/semi-private dressing areas to our team participants.

I greatly appreciate your cooperation with the above guidelines. I believe we can all agree that it is more convenient to have your own dressing area than to have to share with several other teams. Your cooperation will insure that I can continue to provide the private/semi-private dressing areas for next year's contest.
